



# Auctioneering Program

The auctioneering program meets all educational course requirements necessary to sit for the Pennsylvania State auctioneer licensing exam.



## How long does it take to complete?

The program is ten weeks long. Classes are held on Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday from 9:00am to 6:00pm

## What does this program cost?

The cost for the program is \$3,800.00.

## What is the class format?

The class is *taught live in an interactive, remote format* that requires students to log in and be present online during class.

## Is financial aid available?

No, this program is not eligible for financial aid.

## Are there scholarships?

Yes. Partial, needs-based scholarships are awarded to those who qualify. Students will be responsible for remaining tuition and fees. Approved for VA and OVR funding.

## What topics will be covered?

- Learning the "auctioneer chant"
- Appraisals-antiques, autos, dolls, coins, jewelry, furniture, and more
- Auction laws
- Auctioneering software and online auctions.

## What is practicum?
