How long does it take to complete?

The program runs three evenings per week from 5:00pm to 9:00pm for 15 weeks.

What does this program cost?

The cost for the program is \$2,495.00.

Are there additional costs?

No, books and fees are covered in the program cost.

Are there scholarships?

RACC does not offer scholarships for the Pharmacy Technician program at this time.

What classes will I take?
