

# MEDICAL ASSISTANT

Enroll in our Medical Assistant program at Reading Area Community College to start a profession that combines healthcare administration with patient care. As a medical assistant you will play a crucial role as a liaison between patients and healthcare professionals. Monitoring patient vital signs, documenting medical histories, administering injections, and laboratory tests are all covered in detail in our program. Our program prepares you for success as a medical assistant in a variety of healthcare settings.

**How long does it take to complete?** The program is divided into two 15-week semesters and includes a 195-hour internship in the last semester.

**What does this program cost?**

The cost for the program is \$8,861.76.

**Are there any additional costs?**

Yes, you will be responsible for the cost of additional supplies such as books, scrubs, and appropriate shoes.

**Is financial aid available?**

- A completed health screening
- Proof of vaccinations
- Proof of valid health insurance
- CPR (Can be completed within the program),
- Transportation to and from internship sites
- High School Transcripts/GED,
- Valid State ID (i.e., Driver's License)
- Scrubs, appropriate shoes, etc.
