RACC's Auctioneering Program provides comprehensive, hands-on training designed to prepare you for success and fulfills all the educational requirements needed to sit for the Pennsylvania State Auctioneer Licensing Exam. We equip students with real-world skills—from mastering the fast-paced auctioneering chant to gaining practical experience alongside professional auctioneers. With 80% of graduates earning their license and moving into the field with a competitive edge in the auction industry.

How long does the program take to complete?

This is a **10-week** program. Classes are held Tuesdays and Wednesdays from 9 AM - 4:30 PM. Scholarships are available to those who qualify.

What does this program cost?

The estimated cost of the program is **\$3,800** including books. Students will gain practical experience alongside professional auctioneers and become certified.

Outcomes:

- Learn the "Auctioneering Chant"
- Create appraisals for antiques, cars, livestock, etc.
- Learn about auctioneering law
- Learn about auctioneering software and online events
- 60 hours of hands-on observation with pro auctioneers
