TAOC – History

Required coursework: 6 credits in US History and World History (HIS110, HIS-115, HIS-120 and HIS-125) Recommended coursework: COM-121; COM-151; MAT-150 or MAT-210; an additional approved Natural Science with lab; SOC-130 and ANT-140; 2 courses in foreign language or COM-131 and additional approved HUM elective.

TAOC – Sociology

Required coursework: SOC130 and 12 credits in SOC courses; COM-121; COM-151; MAT-210 and additional MAT; two approved Natural Science courses with labs; PSY130 and ANT140; two approved HUM electives.
