# TAOC – History

# TAOC – Sociology

Required coursework: SOC130 and 12 credits in SOC courses; COM-121; COM-151; MAT-210 and additional MAT; two approved Natural Science courses with labs; PSY130 and ANT140; two approved HUM electives.
