Special Advising Notes:

The Practical Nursing Program is a full-time day program. Entrance to the PN Program is selective and determined by meeting the minimum practical nursing prerequisites outlined in Section 1a and 1b of this check sheet. Students must complete appropriate items and coursework in Section1a and 1b of this check sheet before submitting a Practical Nurse Clinical Petition for Admission (students may submit a clinical petition with <u>no more than two</u> required pre-requisites in section 1a and 1b being completed during the fall semester).

Clinical seats are then assigned according to cumulative GPA. Clinical Petitions are due in **September** and are selected based on cumulative GPA. Petitions can be obtained and submitted in the Welcome Center B001. Please refer to the posted deadline date online at https://www.racc.edu/. If the petition is submitted after the deadline, the student will need to reapply for the following year.

All courses in Section 1 and Section 2 must be completed in **one or two attempts**. Any course taken for the third attempt **will disqualify the student** from clinical consideration. Additionally, **no more than 12 credits** can be repeated in Section 1, Section 2, or Section 3 for any reason. Students who withdraw from Clinical may only be re-admitted once.

Due to the selectivity of this program, the importance of course sequencing and the priority deadlines of this program, it is strongly encouraged that you **meet regularly** with your advisor.

Section 4 of this check sheet is **NOT REQUIRED** for PN Students. However, students do have the available option of completing this degree option in addition to the PN Certificate. Please see your advisor for more details.
