Financial Aid Eligibility is based on Satisfactory Academic Progress.

To make Satisfactory Progress, you must:

Maintain the GPA required by the number of credits you've attempted.

Attempted Hours	Minimum GPA
1-10	1.00
11-20	1.5
21-30	1.75
31+	2.00

- **Complete 66% of the credits you attempt.**
- Complete your whole degree within 150% of the hours required for your degree.

Financial Aid Warning



- Status assigned to a student who fails to make SAP at an institution <u>that evaluates SAP at the end of</u> <u>each payment period</u>
- Student may continue to receive Title IV aid for one payment period
- No appeal necessary

SAP

Appeal



Must specify the conditions under which a student may appeal. The student's appeal must include:

- ***** Why the student failed to make SAP; and
- What has changed that will allow the student to make SAP at the next evaluation

SAP

Financial Aid Probation



- Status assigned by an institution to a student who fails to make SAP and who has appealed and has had eligibility for Title IV aid reinstated
- Institution may impose conditions for student's continued eligibility to receive Title IV aid
