Eligible students must have **completed** at least six honors credits, maintained a 3.25 GPA (excluding developmental courses) and have a B or higher in all honors courses. Current recipients of the Honors Scholars Award (full 2 year scholarship) are not eligible to apply. Previous recipients of this scholarship may reapply after they have completed an additional 6 Honors credits.
